The Vital Statistics Registrar files and records all births and deaths that occur inside Hancock County. Birth Certificates are issued for anyone born in the state of Ohio. Death Certificates are issued for those deaths that occur inside the limits of Hancock County. The Registrar can assist with affidavits to correct errors on certificates and establish paternity.
