The Findlay-Hancock County Public Library has been serving the community since 1890. The library offers books, movies, music and much more to library users of all ages at the main library in downtown Findlay and at the Arlington branch. Our Bookmobile brings library service to the small communities of Hancock County on a weekly basis. In addition to programs for all ages, the library also provides StoryWalks at three locations and partners with community organizations to provide library access at community events.



Boots to Business Reboot

Boots to Business Reboot is an entrepreneurial education and training program offered by the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA). Mileage Reimbursement Rate Increase

The IRS has announced an increase in their previously set 2022 optional standard mileage reimbursement rate for the remaining 6 months of the year. Effective July 1st the standard mileage rate for the use of a car (also vans, pickups or panel trucks) is now:

- 62.5 cents (previously 58.5 cents) per mile driven for business use
- 22 cents (previously 18 cents) per mile driven for medical, or moving purposes for qualified active-duty members of the Armed Forces
- 14 cents per mile driven in service of charitable organizations; the rate is set by statute and remains unchanged from 2021
